### A Message from our Chairperson

The Ronald McDonald House Charities, Ireland, supports families whose children are seriously ill in hospital. We accomplish this through our Ronald McDonald House. Our House provides a caring and supportive environment for 20 families every night while their seriously ill children are hospitalised or undergoing treatment at Our Lady's Children's Hospital, Crumlin, Dublin 12.

We cannot provide this service without support. Our annual running costs are in excess of €325,000. This money is raised each year through our many fundraising events. I would like to take this opportunity to thank all of our very generous supporters. Your generosity makes an enormous difference to so many families.

I would like to extend my appreciation and my gratitude to all our Board Members who give so willingly and so freely of their time and commitment throughout the year.

Since we opened in November 2004 we have provided a very valuable and necessary service for in excess of 2,602 families from all over Ireland which amounts to almost 60,674 bed nights. It is not numbers that makes our House a Home. It's the people - the staff, the volunteers, the donors, the families and the community. It is the warmth, the sharing of joy and sorrow, the listening ear and the supportive hug, the courage and the love that makes our House a Home. 
# Message from the Treasurer / Pat Keogh



#### Message from one of our Volunteers: Margaret Brogan


My name is Margaret Brogan and I am 78 years old. I have been a volunteer in the Ronald McDonald House for the past ten years. I have one daughter and she gave me three wonderful grandchildren and I looked after them while she worked until they became too old to be minded. At this stage I was in my middle sixties and began to feel a bit redundant. I had a lot of time on my hands and there was only so much housework one could do or indeed wanted to do.

My daughter suggested voluntary work but I thought I would be considered too old for anything. Then I saw a notice in a shop window on Errigal Road looking for volunteers for the Ronald Mc Donald House which had opened six months previously. I had never heard of the R Mc D House but my daughter told me that it was a place where relatives of children who were in Our Lady's Hospital could stay.

I went to the House and met Mairéad and the rest is history. I volunteer on Tuesdays and Fridays and am flexible with my days. It was a new lease of life for me. I began to feel that I was needed again. The girls and lads in the house (staff and volunteers) are all a good bit younger than me and make sure I don't overdo it. I really look forward to the days I volunteer and enjoy the banter with them all. I also love meeting the parents and their children and hope I am a good listener if they feel like talking. I hope that I have another few years left in me to continue going up to the House. So do we!

### **Family Stories**



#### Galway

'It is a roller-coaster of good and bad days. You feel like your child is making great progress and then they take two steps back. All the worrying and stress takes its toll'.

The Hickey family have stayed in the Ronald McDonald house on two occasions while their daughter Kate was in hospital. They say the support they received within the house is phenomenal as having friends in similar situations provided a helping hand and an open ear for families makes all the difference at the end of a stressful day. They have also stayed in contact with a few of the people that they met in the House and it is great to hear feedback on how other children are coming along and recovering.

'This Facility provided immediate relief to our accommodation problem during the most traumatic time of our lives; it was one less stress that we didn't have to think of'.

The Hickey family believe the new House will have a huge benefit to other families although there is room for up to 20 families at the moment in Crumlin, there is still a waiting list for rooms every night.

The Hickey family were amazed at the support the House received from different companies who came in and cooked meals for the families which is always very much appreciated, something that seems so simple but means so much to the families. Liam Hickey ran the Dublin City Marathon raising an amazing €5,800 for the House.

#### Waterford

For many families staying at the Ronald McDonald House, adjusting is a difficult process: It is so difficult coming to terms with an enormous diagnosis, facing a very uncertain future and all when far away from home, familiar surroundings, family and friends.

'Muireann was awaiting a heart transplant and wouldn't eat any hospital food. I was able to cook food for her in Ronald McDonald House and bring it over to the hospital. The house is a community of support for many. So many nights after a very difficult day in the hospital we returned to the house where we would sit with others who were going through something similar or indeed very different, we'd chat over tea about what was going on for our particular child, listen to their stories, worries and fears too and support each other. These parents were very often the only ones who truly knew what you were going through as they had the same worries and fears for their children as we had for our own'.

'Being able to bring Muireann over to the Ronald McDonald House and escape from the hospital for a while when she began to recover was definitely a highlight. I cannot imagine having to go through all that again without being able to avail of the facilities of this beautiful home and the care and support of the incredible staff there'

'We are deeply indebted to the wonderful people who helped us through some of our darkest days and we have definitely made lifelong friends from our stays there' (Joan, Muireann & Christóir)

# Planning for the Future

#### The New National Children's Hospital at St. James's Hospital

A long awaited decision was reached in 2012 to build The New National Children's Hospital on a site on the grounds of St James's Hospital in Dublin. The hospital will be built on a 6.3 hectare site on the campus of the south inner city hospital and will be finished by the end 2020

The development of the New National Children's Hospital will be the biggest capital project during the lifetime of the current Government. It will merge the three children's hospitals - Temple Street, Crumlin (RMH) and Tallaght - at a single location. The Minister for Health Leo Varadkar has said the new Children's Hospital will be fully operational in 2020. The Minister says construction will be finished in 2019 and that the hospital will open in 2019 in part – and fully 2020.

#### A New Ronald McDonald House

We opened the first Ronald McDonald House on the grounds of Our Lady's Children's Hospital in November 2004. Within a year of opening we heard that a New National Children's Hospital was to be built in Dublin. With only 16 bedrooms in our House and a serious demand for rooms we opened an additional 4 rooms to provide for our families. With news of a New Hospital in a new location we have been reluctant to expand until we received confirmation of the new hospital and the location. With the Government commitment now confirmed we are working closely with the New Hospital Development Board and making definite plans to build a New 50 bedroom Ronald McDonald House alongside the new hospital.

2015 will be a very exciting year for everyone involved with The Ronald McDonald House Charity, Ireland, as we look to formalise our agreement with the New Hospital Board and continue our Capital Campaign that will see us raise the money that will be required to build our 'New Home'. We will need to continue to rely on the generosity of our many supporters to help us realise our ambitious plan.
