The Ronald McDonald House - How it all began

Ronald McDonald House Charities was born out of the unlikely partnership of Dr Audrey Evans, an oncologist at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, McDonald's and an American Football team - the Philadelphia Eagles.



Fred Hill, a player for the Philadelphia Eagles, had a daughter, Kim, suffering from leukaemia, which prompted the team to raise in excess of \$100,000 dollars to support the hospital. This was met with much gratitude from Dr. Evans and her team but also with a request for another \$32,000 to fund a house in which families of children in the hospital could get proper rest, away from the ward.

This request was met by Ed Rensi, an area manager for McDonald's. The company offered to donate the proceeds from their 'shamrock shake' to the cause. In return Ed asked that the house be known as the Ronald McDonald House.

On 15 October 1974, the first Ronald McDonald House opened its doors in Philadelphia. In 1984 the Ronald McDonald charities was officially established in memory of McDonald's Corporation founder Ray Kroc, a strong advocate for children. In the intervening years Ronald McDonald House Charities has formed new and independent chapters in over 62 regions and countries.

There are now 365 *Ronald McDonald Houses in 42 countries, 214 *Ronald McDonald Family Rooms in 23 countries and 50 *Ronald McDonald Care Mobiles in 9 countries. In 2012 RMHC was honored by the American Hospital Association as an exceptional partner in the delivery of health care services. Today at least one RMHC Core Programme* provides care for families being served at 89% of top children's hospitals worldwide. RMHC is the world's leading NGO supporting the accommodation needs of families with children receiving treatment at a hospital.

On the 8th November 2004 the first Irish Ronald McDonald House opened on the grounds of Our Lady's Children's Hospital, Crumlin. On 3rd March 2010 we opened our second House. The Ronald McDonald House in Ireland looks after 20 families every night. Since 2004 we have provided accommodation, care and support for in excess of 3,000 families from all over Ireland.



A Message from our Chairperson



It is my pleasure to once again present the Annual Report from the Board of Trustees of the Ronald McDonald House Charities, Ireland.

The Ronald McDonald House Charities in Ireland supports families whose children are seriously ill in hospital. We accomplish this through our Ronald McDonald House. Our House provides a caring and supportive environment for 20 families every night while their seriously ill children are undergoing treatment at Our Lady's Children's Hospital, Crumlin, Dublin 12.

The last year has been a very busy one for the Charity. The demand for the services provided is ever increasing. Last year we looked after 305 families from all over Ireland. Our annual running costs are in excess of €400,000. This money is raised each year through our many fundraising events and the generosity of our many families and supporters.

It is important to take this opportunity to thank all of our very generous supporters. Your generosity makes what we do possible and results in an enormous difference for so many families.

On behalf of the Board, I would like to express our gratitude to Marian Carroll, our CEO (volunteer) and all of her staff and volunteers who make such a worthwhile contribution to so many families at a time of great vulnerability and need. Since we opened in November 2004 we have provided a very valuable and necessary service for over 3,000 families from all over Ireland which amounts to over 74,576 bed nights. It is not numbers that makes our House a Home. It's the people - the staff, the volunteers, the donors, the families and the community. It is the warmth, the sharing of joy and sorrow, the listening ear and the supportive hug, the courage and the love that makes our House a Home.

RMHC is committed to the highest standards of governance. 
Message from the Treasurer / Dave Bobbett



Mayo Family: Having a baby is a beautiful experience. Our 3rd child, Shannon, was born in Co. Mayo on 3rd June 2016. While her birth was still beautiful, it was also filled with fear, anxiety and total helplessness. Shannon was transferred to Our Lady's Hospital, Crumlin, Co. Dublin straight after being born as she has an extremely serious heart condition. Shortly after being discharged myself and my partner Pat made our way to Dublin. The nurses in the hospital informed us about the Ronald McDonald House. It truly is a home from home. Being so far away from our other two children, family and friends was an emotionally draining and very lonely time. Having the Ronald McDonald House has been an absolute lifesaver. We could have our other children up at the weekends or family or friends could visit. The staff are so friendly and do an amazing job supporting you through the difficult times. The families we met there gave us hope, help and friendship. We all support one another. Shannon is currently 8 months old and has never been home. Without the Ronald McDonald House, we would never have managed emotionally and financially. I really just can't praise the staff enough. The House has such a relaxed environment, which is just what you need after a

long tiring day in the hospital. Volunteers also come in daily to cook meals for all the families, such incredible, selfless people who like to help. The Ronald McDonald House will be top of our list for any fundraising we do in the future. Thank you so much guys for everything.



Galway Family: When our daughter Madison was born in June 2016 we knew we would be spending the first few months of her life in Our Lady's Childrens Hospital. One of our worries as someone coming to Dublin from Galway with no family in the area was where will we stay to be close to Madison. Then we learned of the Ronald McDonald House. Our prayers were answered.

The Ronald McDonald House isn't just a room to sleep at night. It's a wonderful place with amazing staff and volunteers who are always there to help in any way they can. It's somewhere to go when you need a break from the hospital environment but is still close enough that you're only a few minutes away if you're needed.

Planning for the Future

The New Children's Hospital

A New Children's Hospital will be built on the grounds of St James's Hospital in Dublin. The hospital will be built on a 6.3 hectare site on the campus of the south inner city hospital and will be finished by the end 2020

The development of the New Children's Hospital will be the biggest capital project during the lifetime of the current Government. It will merge the three children's hospitals - Temple Street, Crumlin (RMH) and Tallaght - at a single location. Minister for Health Simon Harris has said that the development



of the new children's hospital is a priority for him. "Bringing the three children's hospitals under one roof for the first time on a campus shared with St. James's so that children, young people, families and staff can avail of the facilities that they need and deserve, is a priority for me." At our Gala Ball in November 2015 then Minister for Health, Leo Varadkar, thanked all our guests for their ongoing commitment to and support for The Ronald McDonald House in Ireland. He said that this wonderful facility, provided for families at no cost to the State, is very much appreciated by the Government and The Department of Health. He also said that those who generously support the work of the Charity have made an enormous contribution to healthcare in Ireland.

New Ronald McDonald House

We opened the first Ronald McDonald House on the grounds of Our Lady's Children's Hospital in



November 2004. Within a year of opening we heard that a New National Children's Hospital was to be built in Dublin. With only bedrooms in our House and a serious demand for rooms we opened an additional 4 rooms to provide for our families. With news of a New Hospital in a new location we have always been reluctant to expand until we received confirmation of the new hospital and the location. With the Government

commitment now confirmed and planning permission in place we are working closely with the New Hospital Development Board and working towards raising the €16 million in order to build a New 53 bedroom Ronald McDonald House alongside the new hospital. Exciting and challenging times ahead for The Ronald McDonald House Charity.
