The Ronald McDonald House provides accomodation and a caring and supportive environment for families whose children are seriously ill and are hospitalised or undergoing medical treatment at Our Lady's Children's Hospital, Crumlin, Dublin 12.

The Ronald McDonald House Charities in Ireland supports families whose children are seriously ill in hospital. Our House provides a caring and supportive environment for 20 families every night while their seriously ill children are undergoing treatment at Our Lady's Children's Hospital, Crumlin, Dublin 12.

In 2019 we had the privilege of providing care and vital resources to 296 children and their families from across the island of Ireland. RMHC proudly provides access to quality health care and helps to ensure that families can be actively involved and participate in their children's care. Our Annual Report affords us the opportunity to share our story and thank the many people who make what we do every day possible. Your generosity makes an enormous difference for so many families.

On behalf of the Board of RMHC Ireland, I would like to express our gratitude to Marian Carroll, our volunteer CEO and all the staff and volunteers who make such a worthwhile contribution to so many families at a time of great vulnerability and need.

RMHC is committed to the highest standards of governance. 

With only 2 full-time staff member and 11 part time staff a considerable amount of work was done by RMHC Ireland in 2019 by some very special and dedicated people. We could not look after our families without the help and support of our staff and our many wonderful volunteers. In 2019 we cared for 296 families from 30 different counties. In November 2019 we celebrated 15 years of caring for families. Since 2004 we are proud to say that we have cared for in excess of 4,073 families. Always remember it is not numbers that makes our House a Home. It's the people - the staff, the volunteers, the families and the community. It is the warmth, the sharing of joy and sorrow, the listening ear, the supportive hug, the courage and the love that makes our House a Home.

In addition to our Staff & Volunteers we have so many individuals and companies who make a special effort to help us throughout the year. I would like to say a special Thank You to all of you. Looking after our Families is possible because of your support and generosity. A full list of all our sponsors, donors and supporters can be found at the back of this report.

In March 2019 we heard the sad new of the passing of John Blake, McDonald's Owner Operator in Cork. John was always an incredible supporter of the work of RMHC Ireland. He is sadly missed by all of us here who knew him. Ar dheis Dé go raibh a anam dílis.

In 2019 we continued to work very closely with Children's Health Ireland, The New Children's Hospital Development Board and the HSE with a view to providing a new 53 bedroom Ronald McDonald House alongside the New Children's Hospital. Raising the necessary €19 million remains a challenge but a challenge we face everyday with determination and enthusiasm knowing that families will need us to provide the care and support they will need when their children will be long term ill in The New Children's Hospital.

Throughout 2020 we will continue to provide accommodation, care and support for 20 families every night whose children will be inpatient in Our Lady's Hospital in Crumlin. We will also continue to raise the funds that are required to provide our service here in Crumlin and help us build our New House alongside the New Children's Hospital.

We are delighted to share our journey with our many friends and supporters and we kindly ask you to continue to support us as you have so generously done for over fifteen years. With your help we will continue to keep families close and together at a very difficult time in their lives.





The O'Loughlin Family, Co. Wexford

On the 2nd of February 2017, we welcomed our 3rd child in Wexford General Hospital. However 24 hours later Darragh began to show signs that he was not coping well. He was transferred to Our Lady's Hospital Crumlin via ambulance and was admitted to the Children's Heart Centre.

Over the next few hours a Cardiologist came to explain that our son had a Complex Heart Defect. At 2 days old, he had his first investigative Cath Lab procedure and was scheduled for Open Heart Surgery at 6 days old. This surgery was an in-term surgery to give him some support to allow to get bigger and stronger before he needed his Repair Surgery.

We got a room in Ronald McDonald House. It is difficult to put into words what a difference this made us. We had 2 children at home, who could only come up for day visits prior to this, and although they wanted to come to visit, a hospital is not a place for healthy, active children. A room in the House meant that we could all stay together, sit down to a meal together, play in the playroom and visit the hospital.

Our children called it the 'Holiday House', they loved to come to visit. It was a place, we could sit with our parents, family or friends who visited and drink a cup of tea, it was a place to come at the end of a long, stressful day in the Hospital and sit down and unwind and try to feel 'normal', a friendly chat, a quiet moment, a place to enjoy a healthy, home-cooked meal, a place to get a good night's sleep to get up next day and go through the same, long hospital day.

We went on to spend a further 7 weeks in ICU recovering surgery, extending our admission to 19 weeks. We have had 2 more admissions in Crumlin Hospital and both times have been lucky to get a room here. I could not have imagined spending all this time in Crumlin Hospital without our room in The Ronald McDonald House.

We continue to support RMHC anytime we can through fundraising efforts. We have returned as a family to cook for current families staying there and have donated monies raised from a coffee morning our family organised. Thank you for your amazing work and I cannot express the difference it has made to our family.

Ronald McDonald House was such a blessing to us while our baby Noah received life saving treatment in Crumlin Children's Hospital. We stayed at the house on two separate occasions while Noah underwent open heart surgery for his complex cardiac condition.

When Noah was born he was airlifted from Letterkenny to Crumlin. It was such a stressful and worrying time. You don't really stop to think about the practicalities of being so swiftly uprooted from home to a hospital when you have such a critically ill baby. Ronald McDonald House meant we didn't have to worry about where we would stay and the associated financial burden.

Ronald McDonald House was our home while we couldn't be at home. The staff were so kind and supportive and it was a place where we could get some respite after long draining days in the hospital.

Above everything, the House helped us to stay close together as a family. Not only were we able to be close to Noah, but our other three children were able to stay with us. That really helped to cushion the disruption to family life. Being able to share a meal together and spend some quality time together meant so much. Our children loved the House! They loved the ice-cream fridge and the play room. They made friends and were able to have some fun.

We're very grateful to Ronald McDonald House because they helped to limit the impact on family life for us at that time. And even through a very traumatic time we have some lovely memories!

The New Children's Hospital

A New Children's Hospital is currently under construction on the the grounds of St James's Hospital in Dublin. The hospital will be built on a 6.3 hectare site on the campus of the south inner city hospital and will be opened by Q1 2023.

The New Children's Hospital is the most significant capital investment project ever undertaken in healthcare in Ireland. It will merge the three current children's hospitals -Temple Street, Crumlin and Tallaght at a single site.

New Ronald McDonald House

RMHC Ireland continue to work closely with the CHI Board, the New Hospital Development Board and the HSE in order to build and operate a new 53 bedroom Ronald McDonald House alongside the new hospital.

Raising the €19 million required to build the new House is a serious challenge but one we face with enthusiasm and determination as we know families whose children will be inpatient at the new hospital will need the first class care and comfort only a Ronald McDonald House can provide.
