What is a gift in your will?

A gift in your will is simply a distribution from what you own to a charitable organization through your last will and testament. Some people choose to leave a gift to a cause that is close to them or their loved ones. Choosing to leave a gift in your will to RMHC Ireland can make a massive difference to the families of very sick children.



There are different types of gifts you can leave:

- A residual legacy is a share or percentage of your whole estate. Usually, it is shown as a percentage of your estate once all expenses, debts and specific gifts have been taken out.
- A pecuniary legacy is a fixed sum of money.
- Specific gifts or bequests are personal possessions, including property.

Leaving a gift in your will is an extremely tax-efficient way to give to a charity. In fact, legacies to charity are completely free of Inheritance Tax. It means that should you decide to add RMHC to your will, the House and the families leaving here will receive 100% of any gift you choose to leave.

Making your will is one of the most important decisions of your life. Leaving a gift to RMHC is a simple way to ensure that the Ronald McDonald House stays open for the years to come and continue to provide so much love to our families.

A gift in your will is really easy to arrange. It is a straight forward process and will give you the peace of mind that your family, friends, other responsibilities and charities of your choice will benefit as per your wishes.

The steps you should take to make sure your planned gift will be directed to Ronald McDonald House Charities Ireland are the following:

1. Make a detailed list of your assets (financial, real estate, vehicles...) and decide how much you want to give to the charity.
2. Set up an appointment with your solicitor who will help you write your will. If you do not have a solicitor or financial adviser, please contact us and we will guide you to one. If you already have a will and you wish to add RMHC Ireland to it, ask your solicitor to add a codicil. It will amend your will.
3. Contact us to let us know how we can make honour to your fantastic gift and make it have a long-lasting impact in the lives of sick children and their families.



Your gift can change the life of a family

Small or big, your gift will have an impact now and into the future. It will provide a home and really important services for sick children and their families.

When baby Noah from the Nee Family in Donegal was born, he suffered from a complex cardiac condition. He had to be airlifted from Letterkenny to Crumlin where he underwent an open-heart surgery. The Nee Family of 5 stayed in the House in a family bedroom and received food, care and support.
