The first Ronald McDonald House opened in Philadelphia, USA.

1997



Ronald McDonald House Charities is set up in Ireland.

2004



We opened the first Irish Ronald McDonald House at Our Lady's Children's Hospital, Crumlin.

2010



We extended our facilities by opening a four-bedroom House in St Mary's Drive. We now provide 20 families every night with accommodation, care and support. Our annual running costs are €500,000.

2013



We launched our fundraising campaign (Gathering Ball) to build a New Ronald McDonald House alongside the New Children's Hospital.

2014



We celebrated 10 years of caring for families from all over Ireland.

2015



We designed a 52 bedroom Ronald McDonald House and submitted plans to An Bord Pleanála alongside plans for the New Children's Hospital.

2016



Planning permission was granted for a New Children's Hospital and a new Ronald McDonald House.

2017



RMHC Wear Your Stripes event launched by Taoiseach Leo Varadkar and Minister for Health Simon Harris.

2018



We continued to work on signing a contract with the HSE and raised funds for the current and the new House.

2019



We celebrated 15 years of taking care of families.

2020



We kept our House open and safe for all our families during the Covid-19 pandemic.

2021



Minister of Health announces appointment of RMHC Ireland as accommodation provider for The New Children's Hospital.

2022



The design of our New House was completed this year.

Our Mission

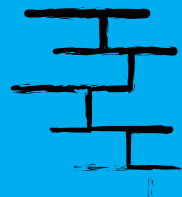
The mission of RMHC Ireland is to provide a Ronald McDonald House in order to support families whose children are seriously ill in hospital.

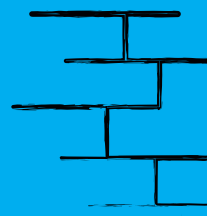
Our Vision

After two very difficult years I am delighted to say that 2022 was a much more positive year for Ronald McDonald House Charities Ireland. Whilst we remained mindful of the dangers and impact of Covid we were very happy to return to a more normal situation in the House as we reverted to full occupation which allowed us care for 20 families every night throughout the year. 2022 also saw the resumption of all our Charity Fundraising Events. The support for these events was incredible and so very much appreciated.

We were delighted to host Minister for Health, Stephen Donnelly, in February 2022. He expressed his gratitude for the care and support we have offered families over the past 18 years and assured us of his support and that of the government for our New House project. This year we made great progress on our New House. The designs are now completed and the tender stage is well in hand.

Since the House opened in November 2004, we have provided a very valuable and necessary service for over 4,743 families from all over Ireland. It is not numbers that makes our House a Home. It's the people - the staff, the volunteers, the donors, the families and the community. It is the warmth, the sharing of joy and sorrow, the listening ear, the supportive hug, the courage and the love that makes our House a Home. A very special word of thanks and appreciation for our CEO, Joe Kenny and the staff for all they did in 2022 to care for our families and for raising the funds required to enable us deliver our mission.

In 2022 we had the privilege of providing care and vital resources to 248 children and their families from across the island of Ireland. RMHC Ireland proudly provides access to quality health care and helps to ensure that families can be actively involved and participate in their children's care. Our Annual Report affords us the opportunity to share our story and thank the many people who helped us get through another year.

A very sincere thank you to the many companies, individuals and our families who supported us throughout the year. A special mention and appreciation for the incredible and ongoing support we received from RMHC Global. On pages 19-23 you will find a complete list of all those who generously supported the work we do.

RMHC Ireland is led by a caring, enthusiastic and committed Board of Trustees who share their insights and expertise to help advance our mission. Their perspective and expertise is critical to enabling us to serve our families. I thank them for their time and good counsel.

RMHC Ireland remains committed to the highest standards of governance. We remain committed to following the Governance Code as set out by the Charities Regulator. As RMHC Ireland looks to 2023 we know we face another challenging and busy year. Whilst our House in Crumlin and the families we care for there will always remain our priority we will continue to work on our long-term objective to develop, build and open a New Ronald McDonald House, adjacent to the New Children's Hospital. We are delighted to advise that construction will begin in Q4 2023.

Access to quality health care and family-centered care is at the heart of our mission. Because of the support of people like you, we remain strongly positioned to continue to deliver on this mission. We have been very busy working with the design team for our new 52-bedroom House at The New Children's Hospital. We are doing our best to replicate our House in Crumlin to ensure we make it a safe and welcoming family home for generations to come. We continue to be guided by our mission statement "To provide accommodation and a caring, supportive environment for families whose children are undergoing medical treatment at CHI Crumlin. To us, keeping families close is what matters the most.

We had an amazing year from a fundraising perspective in 2022 and the team have already secured sponsorship for all of our major events for 2023. The appetite to get back to in person events has been fantastic and we look forward to maximising all our events again this year.

In 2022 we introduced our Wellness Programme for families. The Programme continues to grow from strength to strength, with lots of interaction, pampering and support for our families each week. We have seen a significant change in parents' attitude and focus on the days ahead, for the better, since launching the Wellness Programme. We could not have introduced this Programme without the support of so many and we hope that we can again secure funding this year to continue to grow our Programme.

The operations team looked after 248 families in 2022. Our charity staff once again did an amazing job on the fundraising side.
