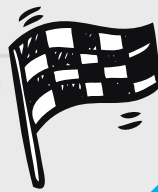

Steps to Fundraising Success

Firstly, choose the type of activity you would like to organise. Ensure it suits your lifestyle and will appeal to your family, friends, colleagues and community.

STEP 1: KEEP IT SAFE! KEEP IT LEGAL!

Make sure you understand your responsibilities as a fundraiser by chatting to the community fundraiser.



STEP 2: REGISTER YOUR FUNDRAISER WITH US

Complete our fundraising registration form (We can post it or you can download it from our website). Once completed return it to us by post. Alternatively call or email the community fundraising manager which we encourage.



STEP 3: SET YOUR TARGET €

Keep it realistic - you can always increase your target later.

STEP 4: SET UP YOUR FUNDRAISING PAGE

Visit: <https://rmhc.enthuse.com/fundraising/start> or set up a **Facebook Fundraiser**. You can personalise your page, add pictures and videos and tell everyone what you are doing to raise money for RMHC Ireland. It's simple it's safe and the money comes straight to the charity.

STEP 5: SHOUT ABOUT IT! & INSPIRE

Let everybody know what you are doing and why! Share your story across social media, set up a facebook event tweet your progress and instagram your photos & videos. Tell your local newspaper or radio station about your fundraising. Inspire your friends, family and work colleagues to join you, sponsor you or better yet, get them to do something amazing too. Use social media to encourage your friends to join in.



What to do when your Event is Finished



Here is all the information you require to send your fundraised money to us. When you officially register your event with us, we will give you a unique Event Reference Number.

Please ensure to use this number when remitting fundraised money online, in person, or at the bank.

ONLINE

If you held a sponsored event and used an online giving page such as www.enthuse.ie or a [facebook fundraiser](#), then money will already be coming straight to us. If not be sure to lodge monies ASAP.

BY HAND

We love nothing more than thanking our fundraisers in person and showing them exactly where all the money you fundraised goes. Someone at reception will be there to receive the money between 10am - 6pm but for a more personal touch be sure to contact & organise with the community fundraising manager.
