“We’ve Got You” Wellness Programme

This family-centred wellbeing programme provides positive support, coaching and workshops to help build resilience, relieve stress and encourage self-care during their stay at the House and through their journey in the hospital with their sick child.

Wellness is all about practicing healthy habits regularly; to attain better mental and physical health outcomes, so instead of just surviving, you're thriving. This is easily and often forgotten when your primary focus is on your sick child.

This additional arm of support for every family member ensures we are looking after both their physical and mental health with an array of in-house and online events for them to avail of, during their stay.

Treasurer's Message

Dear Supporters and Stakeholders,

As the Treasurer of RMHC Ireland, I am honoured to present a summary of our financial results for the fiscal year 2023. Your unwavering commitment to our cause has allowed us to make significant strides toward our mission, and I am pleased to share our financial highlights with you.

Revenue: Our total revenue for the year amounted to €2,909,434, which includes donations, grants, and programme fees. Your generosity has been instrumental in allowing us to continue to care for families at our House in Crumlin while at the same time funding our New Ronald McDonald House in Rialto.

Expenses: We allocated funds judiciously to support our core activities. Major expense categories included program development, administrative costs, and outreach efforts.

New Ronald McDonald House: Capital Donations for New House in 2023 was €161,256. Total sponsorship funds designated for the new House is €3,640,078 at 31st December 2023.

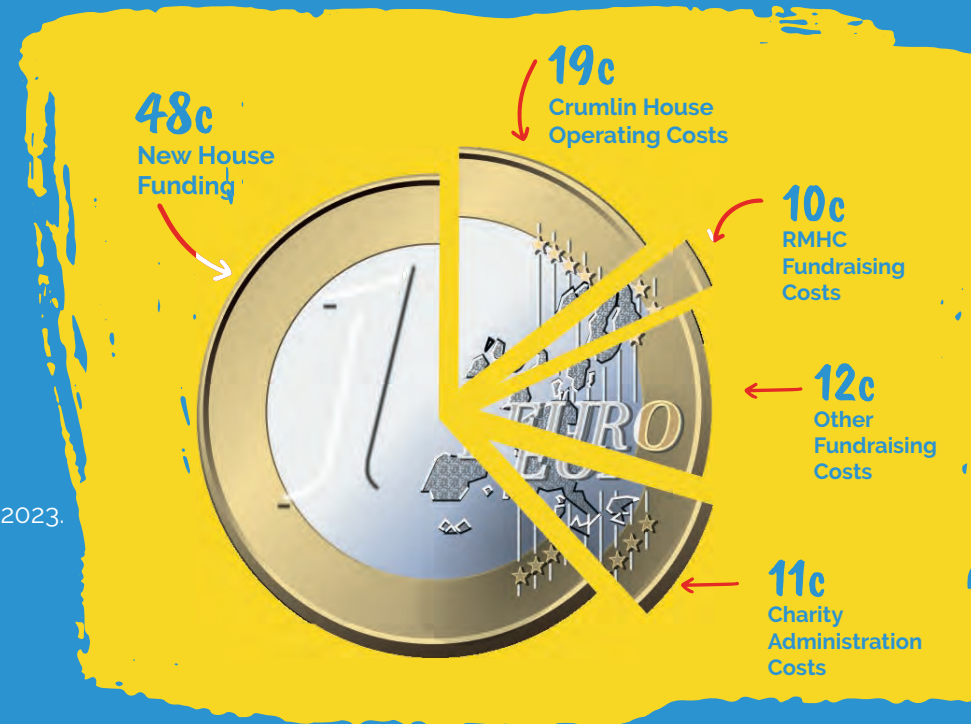
