

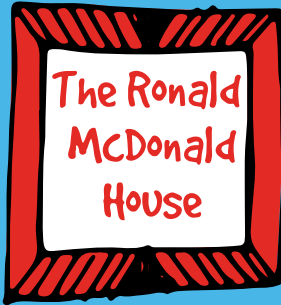

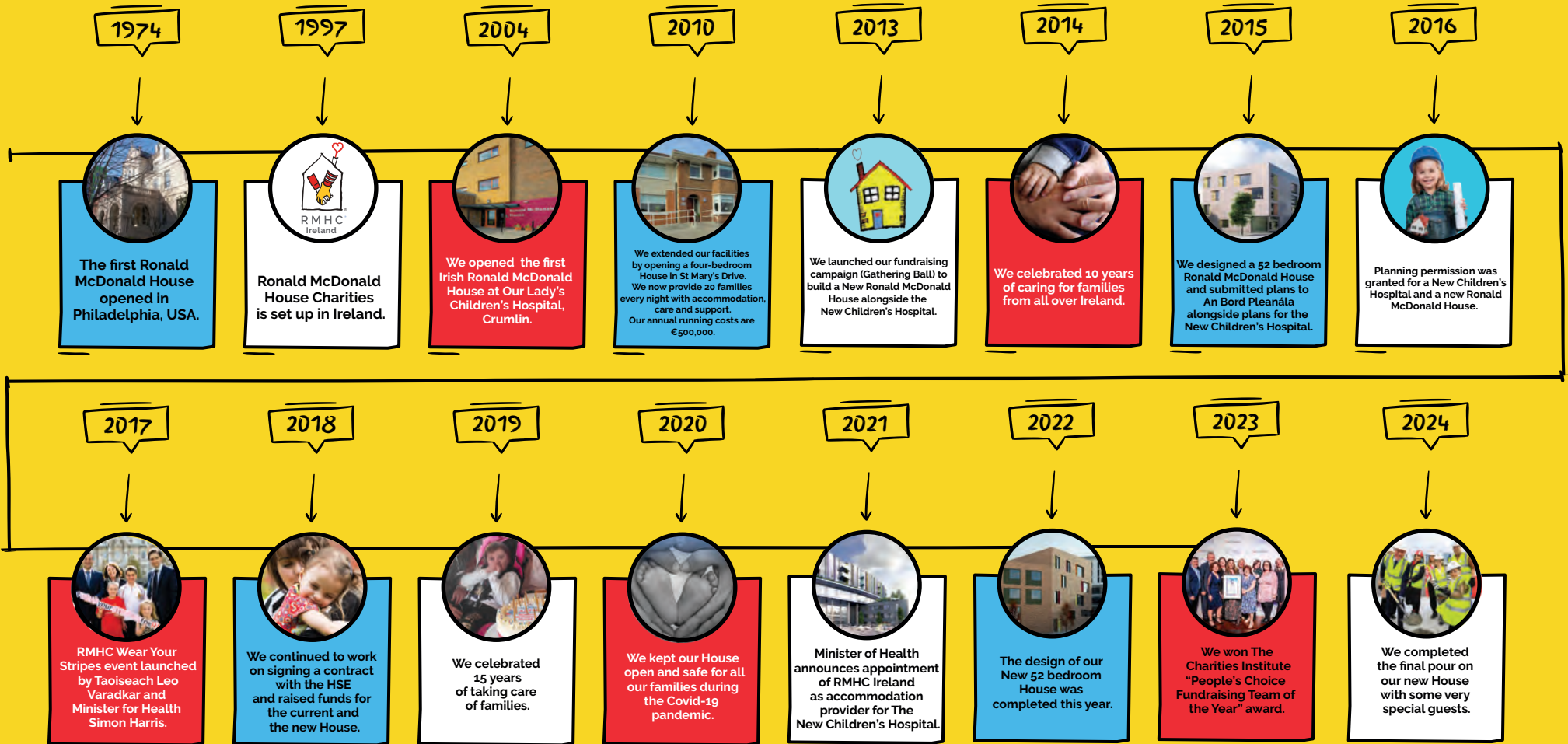

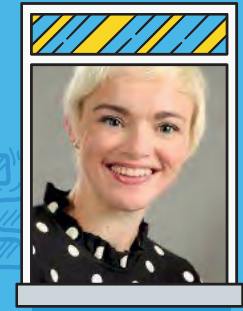

Annual Report Message for 2024

In 2024, we proudly marked 20 years of looking after families at our House in Crumlin. Additionally, we joined the global celebration of 50 years since the first House opened in Philadelphia. These milestones reflect our enduring commitment to providing a "home away from home" for families in need.

We were thrilled to be shortlisted in two categories for the Charities Institute Awards, a testament to our dedication and impact. Our fundraising efforts were bolstered by several wonderful charity events, which brought our community together and supported our mission.

Our House maintained an impressive average occupancy rate of 98%, serving 219 families throughout the year. The average family stay was 30 nights, highlighting the essential support we provide during challenging times.

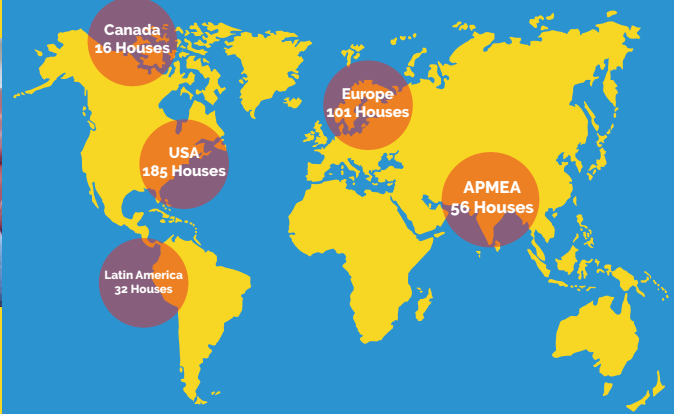

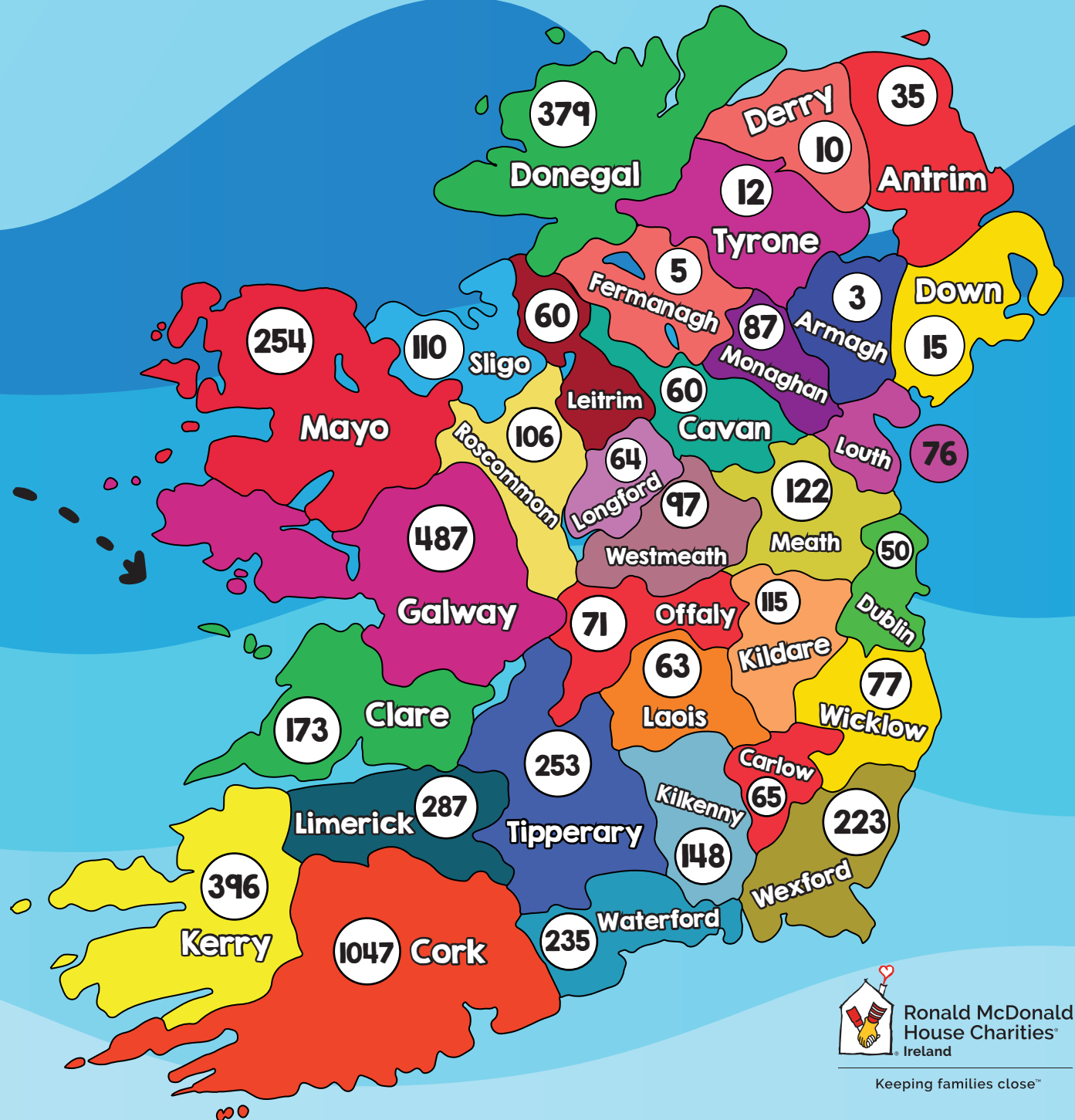

Treasurer's Message

Dear Supporters and Stakeholders,

As the Treasurer of Ronald McDonald House Charities, I am delighted to present a summary of our financial results for the fiscal year 2024. Your unwavering commitment to our cause has enabled us to make significant progress toward our mission, and I am pleased to share our financial highlights with you.

Revenue: Our total revenue for the year amounted to €3,931,341, encompassing donations, grants, and program fees. Your generosity has been crucial in allowing us to continue supporting families at our House in Crumlin while also funding our New Ronald McDonald House in Rialto.

Expenses: We allocated funds prudently to support our core activities. Major expense categories included program development, administrative costs, and outreach efforts.

New Ronald McDonald House: Capital donations for the New House in 2024 totalled €640,165. The total sponsorship funds designated for the new House stood at €2,435,700 as of December 31, 2024.

Transparency: Ronald McDonald House Charities Ireland is committed to efficiency, transparency, and accountability to ensure the funds we receive benefit the families we serve. We have adopted the Charities SORP (FRS102) in our financial statements for 2024. Our full audited accounts for 2024 are available on our website - www.rmhc.ie.
